

Central Coast Regional District REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) 911 CALL SERVICE FEASIBILITY STUDY ADDENDUM #1

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The Central Coast Regional District (CCRD) responds to questions from proponents regarding its recently posted Request for Proposals (RFP) for a *CCRD 911 Services Feasibility Study* issued on January 10th, 2025 as follows:

- 1. In response to questions concerning the total budget authorizations for the works included in the RFP: the Board of Directors has publicly authorized expenses not exceeding \$50,000.
- 2. Page 3 Needs Assessment a. Reads: "Identify the current emergency communication systems in the CCRD for Fire Services, Emergency Services and Police Services."

Please note that this is not anticipated to include radio, paging, smartphone and other communication systems of those respective agencies. It is intended to have the successful proponent understand and report on existing systems for how residents currently make emergency calls for emergency services in the Central Coast Regional District.

This would inform preliminary data gathering for the study and is only expected to be used insofar as it logically informs the implementation of expressed service levels in the RFP (implementation of a 911 Call Service in the Central Coast Regional District).

3. Page 3 – Needs Assessment b. Reads: "Evaluate the gaps and limitations in existing emergency response processes."

Please note that this step is intended to help the successful proponent identify what unique needs and gaps exist in the ways that residents currently make emergency calls for emergency services in the Central Coast Regional District, and is only expected to be used insofar as it logically informs the implementation of expressed

service levels in the RFP (implementation of a 911 Call Service in the Central Coast Regional District).
